Brown Opinion Project: March 2024 Poll Results



Methodology

The Brown Opinion Project (BOP) conducted its March 2024 poll from March 5th - March 7th. BOP solicited responses from Brown undergraduate students near Faunce Hall and Sciences Park. BOP representatives asked every person who passed their location if they were interested in taking a quick anonymous poll. Responses were anonymously collected using Google Forms. Over the course of the polling process, BOP collected 563 total responses from Brown undergraduate students.

Self-Reported Demographic Information

The sample of undergraduate students who took the poll is demographically similar to the Brown undergraduate student population on campus. The sample was 29.1% first-years, 25.8% sophomores, 20.8% juniors, and 24.3% seniors. The sample was 47.6% female, 47.6% male, 6.5% non-binary or genderqueer, 0.9% questioning or unsure; while 0.9% preferred not to indicate their gender. Additionally, 53.6% of respondents identified as white, 34.1% as Asian, 14.2% as Black, 10.1% as Hispanic, 3.7% as Middle Eastern or North African, 1.1% Native American or Alaska Native, 0.9% Native Haiwaiian or Pacific Islander while 2.5% preferred not to answer. The percentages for race add up to more than 100 percent because some respondents identified as Social Science concentrators, 35.5% of respondents identified as Social Science concentrators, 31.1% of respondents identified as Life Science concentrators, and 1.6% of respondents selected prefer not to answer. 3) Should Brown have institutional neutrality?

4) Do you identify more closely with capitalist or communist values?

¹ The results reported here are weighted by class year. There was a large enough deviation between the sample and the assumed grade distribution that we felt it necessary to report weighted averages, especially given the nature of some questions.
